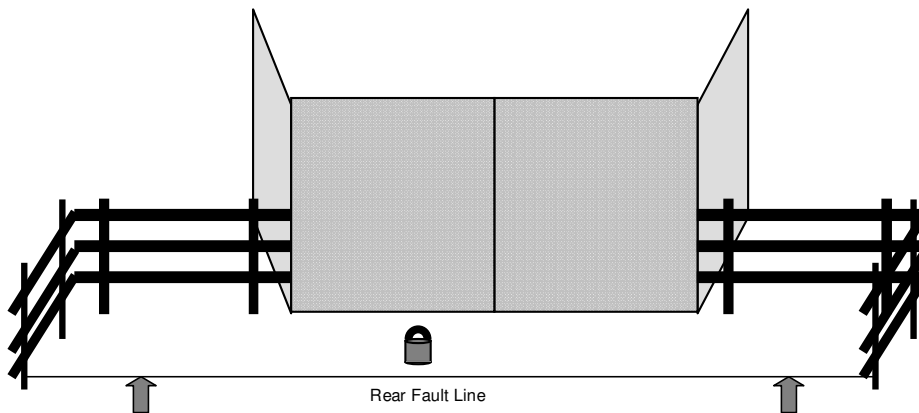
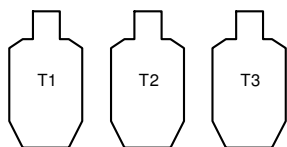
START POSITION: Facing uprange, with toes touching rear fault line at either arrow. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

At the signal and from within the defined shooting area, turn, draw, and engage either plates 1 -3 or targets T1-T3. Shooter must then retrieve and hold water bucket in his or her weak hand while engaging all remaining targets.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 9 rounds, 45 points
TARGETS: 3 IPSC, 3 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



Setup Notes: The water bucket is to be located approximately centered in the shooting area with the same placement used for each shooter

RO Notes: After engaging the first target array, either plates or paper, shooter will receive 1 procedural penalty for each shot fired while not holding the water bucket in their weak hand.
